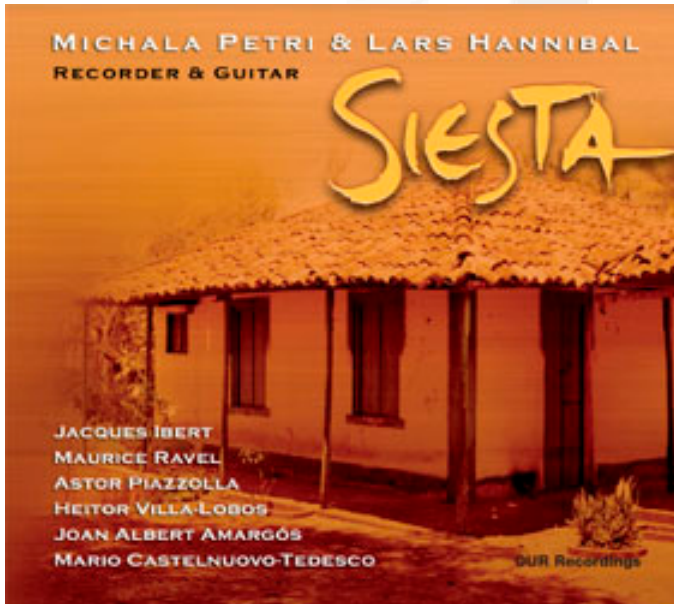

Michala Petri and Lars Hannibal have performed together in more than a thousand concerts around the world. On this new release they have put together a program of works from the last century, which in different ways were inspired by the sensual, languorous world of Latin music. Originally, the word "Siesta" meant a little break from work during the "sixth hour" (counting from dawn, and therefore occurring at midday). This break was intended to allow people time to spend with their friends and family and share a meal together

Throughout this new recording, Michala Petri demonstrates once again her absolute mastery of the recorder – sounding in turns seductive, earthy, ethereal or melancholy. Sensitive accompaniment is provided by Lars Hannibal's guitar, adding that "special" Latin flavor. So pour yourself a delicious Caipirinha, sit back, dim the lights, close your eyes and be transported to a special place– any time!
